Why: A dialogue about the past and our future - about the perpetuation of conflict and its potential resolution - can support community in the UK, and potentially back home in Burundi.

Who: The forum is a gathering for all Burundians and others who care about the future of Burundi, and are interested in exploring the complexity and difficulties of past and present issues in Burundi and in the UK. We invite people of different war experience and ethnic backgrounds to this unique event – to explore together the question of where we go from here, what can we do with our trauma and persisting conflict, and how we might help the situation back home in Burundi.

Who are we? An international facilitation team- using Process Work methods, which draw on ancient and modern methods of finding new pathways towards change and affecting our world.

The Forum is a chance for facilitated dialogue, and to engage together in a way that can begin to heal wounds, and support the changes needed in ourselves and in humanity.

Outcomes after the 2 days: The forum will support community dialogue, experiences and introductory skills for facilitating conflict, including dealing with trauma and issues of accountability, leadership and responsibility. The purpose is to support the wisdom within community, and ongoing dialogue, networking and further projects may evolve.
